I hope you and your family had an enjoyable Christmas break. Please find below some information for the term ahead.

Safety Issues at 2.45pm Collection Time

I would ask you to please be mindful of the children's safety at the 2.45pm collection time. Each day there are cars are pulling up at the school gates and blocking the road for other parents. This forces the children to walk on the road between the cars and is **extremely dangerous** for the children. If you are collecting your child, please pull in to the layby at the school, or park, use the Community Centre or the Chapel car park and keep the road as clear as possible. **Please do not park directly in front of the school gates, at the no parking signs**. The children's safety is our priority and if the parking of cars does not improve at the 2.45pm pickup we will be left with no alternative except to ask parents/ carers to collect their children on foot from the school gates.

Traffic

An official from the Education Authority visited the school on Monday to review the current pickup procedure. It is hoped that her report will help to strengthen the school's case for additional safety measures on the road.
